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Categories & Eligibility

Junior Category :Classes VI to VIII Senior Category : Classes IX to XII

General Rules

- Each school may send one team of two participants per category.
- One student must speak for the motion, and the other against the motion.
- The topic will be shared with schools in advance to ensure fair preparation.
- Each speaker will be given 3minutes to present their argument.
- A grace period of 15seconds will be allowed post the time limit.
- A single bell will ring at the end of 3 minutes.
- A double bell will ring at the end of the 15-seconds grace period.
- Forevery15seconds beyond the time,2 marks will be deducted.
- There will be no rebuttal or repeated rounds.
- Students from each school will debate against their own team mate.(e.g., Participant A speaks for ,and Participant B speaks against the same motion).
- Judging criteria will include content quality, argument structure, clarity, body language, language proficiency, and audience engagement.

Debate Topics

- Junior Category: 'How internet has affected our lives: a boon or a curse'
- Senior Category: 'Reality shows promote unrealistic aspirations among youth'

We encourage schools to seize this opportunity to develop in their students a strong command over logic, confidence in public speaking, and the grace to respect differing opinions. Let this be a stage where ideas don't clash but converse.
